

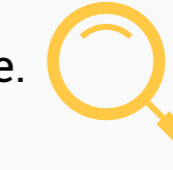
NATIONAL WILLS WEEK

More than 70% of South Africans do not have wills. Read more about the importance of having a will.

What is a will?

A legal document in which you indicate what will happen to your assets when you die. It gives instructions as to how your estate should be distributed after your death.



Why should you get a will?

A will gives you the comfort of knowing that your assets will be distributed and managed according to your wishes. If you have minor children, you can name the guardian you have chosen to look after them.



When should you get a will?

As soon as you can. You must be above the age of 16 years old, and have assets before you create a will.
